**Bill Analysis**

SB 1338 requires the State Department of Education to reimburse an alternative certification applicant for tuition and fees upon successful completion of any courses taken at an institution of higher education that are required by the State Board of Education as part of a professional education component. The measure allows individual public school districts or school districts that have entered into a cooperative agreement to develop professional development courses in pedagogical principles and classroom management to fulfill the requirements for the professional education component.
