Bill Analysis

SB 1348 requires physicians testing the blood of pregnant mothers to also test for the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) in addition to the other diseases provided for in law. Patients may decline to have the test taken.

Fiscal Analysis

FY'21 Impact: Minimal- \$8,700

Full Year Impact: Minimal- \$8,700

SB 1348 requires a test for HIV at the first examination of a pregnant= woman in Oklahoma unless they decline the test. Pending impact but possible savings for early detection. The \$8,700 figure is an estimate for approximately 1,000 of the 30,000 pregnancies covered by OHCA.
