Bill Analysis

SB 1350 directs every state agency providing mental health services to report to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) information related to services provided by the agency, a financial summary of spending amounts in each program, and outcome summaries for mental health services. OMES is directed to compile the information and provide a report to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, Speaker of the House, Legislative Office of Fiscal Transparency no later than November 30, 2020.

SB 1350 will have 11 state agencies submit a report to OMES detailing the mental health services they provide as well as the funding sources and target populations. There will be a minimal cost to compile the information, but that cost will be absorbed by the 11 agencies.
