Bill Analysis

SB 1382 provides for a voter's registration to be cancelled if the voter is identified as deceased or as having moved out of state by a multistate voter list maintenance organization. The measure requires notice of the cancellation to be sent to the last known address on file with the county election board 30 days prior to the cancellation.

The Secretary of the State Election Board is authorized join the state as a member in one or more multistate voter list maintenance organizations, including the Electronic Registration Information Center. The measure also empowers the Secretary and Department of Public Safety to respectively provide voter registration data and motor vehicle license data to the organization. If the organization identifies eligible but not currently registered voter, the Secretary is authorized to notify such citizens about the procedure for becoming a registered voter. The organization may also contact voters who have changed the address of their residence but not their registration address.
