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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1391 broadens the prescriptive authority of Certified Practice Nurses and Clinical Nurse Specialists to include the authority to prescribe and administer Schedule II controlled dangerous substances that are indicated for the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder, provided the nurse is properly specializes in Adult Psychiatric-Mental Health or Child/Adolescent Psychiatric-Mental Health, is properly supervised, and properly registered according to the provisions of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act.

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
