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Bill Analysis

SB 1392 requires assisted living centers to take certain actions when a resident is prescribed an antipsychotic drug. These actions include quarterly assessments for the desired responses and possible side effects of the medication, ensuring all staff understand the benefits and side effects of the medication, note the rationale for using the drug, and monitor at least monthly for inappropriate use.

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
