**Bill Analysis**

SB 140 requires all child-care facilities to implement the recommendations and standards found in the Child and Adult Care Food Program and Healthy Eating Research 2013 Recommendations for Healthier Beverages. Child-care facilities must provide children with opportunities for physical activity. Additionally, the measure requires child-care facilities to limit screen time for children less than two years of age, with some exceptions for educational material and assistive or adaptive technology.
