## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1409 creates the Justice Reform Revolving Fund. The measure transfers any unencumbered funds in the Boating Safety Education Fund and the School Investigative Audit Revolving Fund to Justice Reform Revolving Fund after November 1, 2020.

The measure eliminates the reimbursement provided to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation and other law enforcement agencies to cover the costs of cleaning up an illegal drug laboratory site. Additionally, the measure eliminates the \$10.00 charge levied on vehicle owners for failing to pay all appropriate taxes on a vehicle.

The measure repeals sections of law related to levying an additional \$1,000.00 fine upon persons convicted of a failure to yield at a right-of-way and who causes a fatality or serious bodily injury, violations by parents or legal guardians having responsibility for a minor operating a vessel, and the assessment levied upon person convicted of embezzling school funds.

SB 1409 creates the Justice Reform Revolving Fund, transfers any unencumbered funds in the Boating Safety Education Fund, the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving Fund, and the School Investigative Audit Revolving Fund to this new fund. Eliminates OSBI drug clean-up fee, penalty for failure to register a vehicle. Repeals failure to yield at a right-of-way and who causes a fatality or serious bodily injury, the Motorcycle Safety and Education Program Revolving Fund, violations by parents or legal guardians having responsibility for a minor operating a vessel, and the assessment levied upon person convicted of embezzling school funds.
