Bill Analysis

SB 1424 provides a \$2.00 per hour increase over the current hourly wage, or an equivalent amount if not receiving an hourly wage, of each employee with a job description and location outlined in the measure of the Department of Corrections. The increase will apply to personnel employed by the Department on the last working day of June 1, 2020. The raise shall be reduced by an amount proportional to the raise as provided for in HB 2771 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature.

Introduced– Identifies positions that were inadvertently not included in SB1045 (2019), which provided a \$2/hr pay increase to "behind the wall" DOC personnel. Provides identified positions a \$2/hr pay increase to be reduced by an amount propotional to the increase provided for in HB2771 (2019), which provided a pay increase to all full- and part-time state employees, including temporary and other limited-term employees, but excluded certain state officials.
