**Bill Analysis**

SB 1450 authorizes the Department of Transportation to promulgate rules to develop a smart work zone system. A smart work zone system means an application of computers, communications, and sensor technology to highway transportation that analyze traffic flow, is portable, operates in an automated manner, and provides accurate and reliable information. The Department may contract with third parties who place or provide temporary traffic control devices within or near construction zones.
