Bill Analysis

SB 1458 directs the Oklahoma Tax Commission to adopt a record retention schedule for county assessors. The schedule shall provide for the availability of all public records for no less than 7 years. For records related to an area in any county designated as a tax increment district, the schedule shall provide for the availability of no less than 20 years after the date the incentive or increment district ceases to be operative.
