**Bill Analysis**

SB 153 provides to a charter school that has received a school grade of C or better and been in operation for two or more years with an increased amount of funding equal to their average daily membership (ADM) multiplied by a building fund weight of 1.5. Charter schools that receive a D or lower will receive an increased amount funding based on the school's ADM multiplied by a building fund weight of 0.75. Expenditures from this additional funding may be spent on capital projects.
