Bill Analysis

SB 1533 requires school districts beginning with the 2020-21 school year to designate a minimum of 1 day as industry day for ninth through twelfth grade students to explore career opportunities available at industries in the state. The measure directs districts to collaborate with employers, career and technology center schools and institutions of higher education located in or around the district to provide information to students and allows a district's industry day to be incorporated as part of the Individual Career Academic Plan process, include information about apprenticeships, internships and mentorships and incorporate provisions of Oklahoma Works.
