Bill Analysis

SB 155 requires practitioners to conduct a baseline urine test on patients before writing a prescription for Schedule II controlled dangerous substance or any prescription opioid drug if the initial prescription is longer than three months. The practitioner must also periodically monitor the patient and conduct follow-up random urine drug tests to monitor the patients compliance with their prescription.

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
