Bill Analysis

SB 1607 creates the Controlled Dangerous Substances Scheduled Drug Review Board and provides for a sunset date of July 1, 2025. The measure directs the Board to collect data on dispensing and prescriptive practices related to controlled substances, monitor the prescription monitoring program, recommend investigations, and recommend policies to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control. The Board is authorized to report any policy recommendations, subject to a majority vote, to the Governor, President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and Speaker of the House. Additionally, the Board must hold executive sessions when reviewing and discussing individual cases. The Board shall be comprised of 5 members appointed by the Governor.
