**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 163 broadens the population of sex offenders required to report to the statewide centralized hotline of the Department of Human Services. Current law specifies that the offender be the parent, stepparent, or grandparent of a minor before they are required to report to the hotline. SB 163 strikes these specific terms and broadens the requirement to include any sex offender residing with a minor child.
