Bill Analysis

SB 1634 directs the state to disclose the complete criminal history of an informant, any deal offered to the informant for testimony, specific statements made by the defendant, all other cases in which the informant testified, whether the informant ever recanted his or her testimony, and any other information related to the informant's credibility at least 10 days before the preliminary hearing during discovery.
