**Bill Analysis**

SB 1635 authorizes judges to order the examination of a witness by deposition if good cause exists. Judges are authorized to prescribe terms and conditions to witness examinations. The order shall specify the time, place, and form of the examination. If a mutual agreement between the parties is achieved, the deposition of a witness may be read into the trial as evidence.
