**Bill Analysis**

SB 1640 authorizes any defendant or his or her counsel to submit a written motion requesting the district attorney to produce certain records as outlined in the measure. The defendant or counsel of the defendant may also request to examine the records at a time mutually agreed upon by defense and prosecution. The measure requires such records to be produced within 15 days of receiving the written request. The defendant or counsel may also issue a subpoena duces tecum to any law enforcement entity within the state that assisted in the arrest of the defendant to produce records related to the defendant.
