Bill Analysis

SB 1655 prohibits any residential or commercial roofing contractor from advertise or promise to pay all or part of any applicable insurance deductible or offer to compensate an insured for providing any service to the insured as an inducement to the sale of goods or services. Insurers are not obligated to consider the estimate prepared by a roofing contractor that violates this provision. Additionally, the measure provides for a maximum administrative fine of \$10,000.00 for any contractor violating the provisions of the measure and does not preclude criminal prosecution for a criminal offense related to the violation.
