## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1709 exempts the following state agencies from the provisions of the Information Technology Consolidation and Coordination Act:

- 1) The Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission;
- 2) The Department of Corrections;
- 3) The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation;
- 4) The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training;
- 5) The Board of Medicolegal Investigations;
- 6) The Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control;
- 7) The Department of Public Safety;
- 8) The Office of the Attorney General;
- 9) The Court of Criminal Appeals;
- 10) The District Attorneys Council;
- 11) The District Courts;
- 12) The Supreme Court:
- 13) The Oklahoma Indigent Defense System; and
- 14) The Pardon and Parole Board

Agencies exempted must demonstrate to the Chief Information Officer that cost savings can be achieved.
