Bill Analysis

SB 171 authorizes the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training to certify individuals who have completed training as identified in the Department of Defense (DOD) POST Instruction 5525.1 Guideline 1, which relates to those who served in a full-time military police capacity. Individuals must have served in a military police capacity for six months within the preceding two years and demonstrate firearm qualification and competence as determined by the Council to be eligible for certification.
