**Floor Substitute (FS)**

The FS for SB 1744 authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to create a Livestock Offender Registry. The Registry shall contain all persons who are convicted of stealing livestock or goods relating to maintaining livestock. The Department is also authorized to contract with a statewide livestock organization to create the Registry. The county in which the offender is convicted shall submit a copy of the sentence to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry confirming the conviction.
