**Bill Analysis**

SB 1766 authorizes the use of REAL ID noncompliant driver licenses to be used as proof of identity. The measure also prohibits the Department of Public Safety from requiring proof of identity documentation sufficient for a REAL ID Compliant Driver License for an applicant making application for a REAL ID Noncompliant Driver License.

Provides that a valid and unexpired OK driver license is sufficient proof of identity when applying for a REAL ID Noncompliant ID Card or Driver License.
