Bill Analysis

SB 1777 clarifies the term “reasonable probability” as it pertains to petitioners requesting a hearing after sentencing. Reasonable probability requires a petitioner to provide a preponderance of evidence that shows he or she would not have been prosecuted or convicted if exculpatory results had been obtained through DNA testing.
