Bill Analysis

SB 1791 creates the Farmers Market and Cooperative Act. The measure authorizes farmers, producers, and home food establishments to sell farm and food products to customers at farmers markets and farmers cooperatives either directly or through a trained farmer cooperative manager. The measure requires all goods sold to be in compliance with the Home Bakery Act of 2013. The measure defines non-potentially hazardous food to mean food that does not require time and/or temperature control for safety to limit pathogenic microorganism growth or toxin formation
