## **Bill Analysis**

SB 1798 modifies the statute of limitations for the crimes of child trafficking and human trafficking. The measure changes the statute of limitations for child trafficking from the victim's 45<sup>th</sup> birthday to within 50 years after the discovery of the crime. Human trafficking is changed from 12 years to 50 years after the discovery of the crime.
