Bill Analysis

SB 1798 modifies the statute of limitations for the crimes of child trafficking and human trafficking. The measure changes the statute of limitations for child trafficking from the victim's 45th birthday to within 50 years after the discovery of the crime. Human trafficking is changed from 12 years to 50 years after the discovery of the crime.

Changes the statute of limitations for prosecutions of sexual crimes against children, child abuse, and child trafficking to 50 years after the discovery of the crime. The same change applies for such crimes committed against a victim 18 years old or older.
