Bill Analysis

SB 1804 specifies that the detention of a person arrested for the crimes of domestic abuse, stalking or harassment, or domestic assault and battery or domestic assault and battery with a deadly weapon for 72 hours or longer shall not constitute an unnecessary delay unless the person can establish prejudice by reason of the delay.
