Bill Analysis

SB 1806 directs the State Board of Education, subject to the availability of funds, to allocate \$19 million to award competitive grants to school districts to pay in whole or in part the salaries or wages of a school counselor, licensed professional counselor, or licensed clinical social worker. The measure directs the Board to establish a process to consider grant proposals. The measure states that a district awarded a grant shall require that the activities of the school counselor, licensed professional counselor or licensed clinical social worker whose salary or wages are paid for with the grant to require the activities of the individual to consist of 80% direct services to students and 20% indirect services with others on behalf of students.
