**Committee Substitute (CS)**

The CS for SB 1845 directs the Oklahoma 9-1-1 Management Authority to develop a pilot training program for 9-1-1 operators on or before June 30, 2021. The program shall focus on training operators to recognize the need High-Quality Telecommunicator Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation during acute events requiring Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation. The training must include evidence-based, nationally recognized guidelines for out-of-hospital cardiac arrest and continuous education.
