**Bill Analysis**

SB 1858 directs any health authority charged with enforcing immunization laws to not deny a personal exemption if the parent, guardian, or legal custodian affirms that the child has had an adverse reaction to the immunization to be administered. Personal beliefs and opinions must be accepted by the health authority as a legitimate personal objection.
