**Bill Analysis**

SB 1873 creates the classification of Registered Behavior Technician. A technician is a paraprofessional who is certified by the Behavior Analyst Certification Board and practices under the close, ongoing supervision of a Board Certified Behavior Analyst. The measure amends “supervisee” to conform with the new term. The measure prohibits technicians from designing intervention or assessment plans but authorizes the Board to determine the duties of technicians in general.
