Bill Analysis

SB 1874 creates the term “community paramedic service” in the Oklahoma Emergency Response Systems Development Act. Such services are intended to prevent unnecessary ambulance transportation or hospital emergency department use and must be a part of a care plan offered by a primary care provider. Services shall also include policies and procedures related to patient care. The measure repeals a section of law dealing with emergency response systems provided for by community paramedic services in the measure.
