**Bill Analysis**

SB 1880 exempts persons engaged in “natural healing arts” from current laws and regulations related to licensure. Natural healing arts shall not include surgery, setting fractures, prescribing x-ray radiation, prescribing drugs, diagnosing a physical or mental condition, or falsely representing him or herself as a licensed or certified individual. Any person providing natural healing services must disclose to his or her customers certain information prior to providing services. Failure to comply with the prohibitions or notification requirements shall subject violators to enforcement procedures from relevant boards and agencies.
