Bill Analysis

SB 1882 modifies procedures related to repealing agency rules. The measure authorizes a state agency to begin an expedited rule repeal process after it submits a request for such a process to the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House. Both chambers shall assign the request to the relevant committee designated to conduct the repeal process. The agency must also provide a copy of the rules indicating why the agency is requesting the expedited process. The agency must also provide notice in the Oklahoma Register and allow for a 10-day period for public comments.

After the 10-day period, the committee assigned to conduct the repeal process shall schedule a hearing and vote on the agency rule proposal. If the committee votes to repeal and agrees with the state agency that the repealing action meets one of the criteria outlined in the measure, the rule shall be repealed. No request for an expedited repeal shall be initiated after May 1.

The measure also modifies procedures related to legislative review of proposed rules. The measure shifts the date for the Legislature to receive proposed changes from April 1 to March 1. If the Legislature receives the rules on or before March 1, it shall have until the last day of the regular legislative session of that year to review such rules. If the Legislature receives the rules after March 1, the Legislature shall have until the last day of the regular legislative session of the next year.
