**Bill Analysis**

SB 1901 directs the Oklahoma Employees Insurance and Benefits Board to cooperate with the Oklahoma Health Care Authority by July 1, 2021, to eliminate the use of a third-party pharmacy benefit management company and replace this company with a direct-to-pharmacy payment system.
