Bill Analysis

SB 1903 directs any officer conducting a lethality assessment on a domestic violence victim to implement the referral protocol process to a domestic violence advocate from a certified or tribal program if the results of the assessment indicate a referral is suggested in a certain manner. The officer shall inform the victim of the results of an assessment and that the officer will call the hotline to allow the victim to speak to an advocate. If the victim refuses the call, the officer shall document the refusal. The measure also requires referral information related to domestic violence programs be provided to the victim regardless of the results of the assessment.
