**Bill Analysis**

SB 198 requires state agencies and political subdivisions of the state to develop a social media policy related to the personal use of state employees or any political subdivision of this state to discourage abusive or offensive online behavior. The measure requires agencies and political subdivisions to discourage obscene sexual content, abusive and bullying language, illegal activity, intentionally dishonest conduct that could harm a citizen, and disclosure of confidential information.
