**Bill Analysis**

SB 20 requires all virtual charter schools to maintain an inventory of school supplies purchased with state-appropriated funds. This inventory system will track the name and grade level of any student for whom the supplies are purchased and require said student to return the supplies upon graduation or upon transferring to another school. The parent or legal guardian will reimburse the school if the supplies are not returned. All virtual charter schools will send a copy of their inventory to the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board by December 31, 2019 and each December 31 thereafter.
