Bill Analysis

SB 207 authorizes the Oklahoma Tax Commission to publicly disclose information related to contributions to the Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund. The measure also directs the OTC to make public the names of the two biggest contributors to the Public School Classroom Support Revolving Fund each calendar year. The largest contributing business will be named the "valedictorian" and the largest individual contributor will be named the "salutatorian." If one of the largest contributors opts out the OTC will identify the next largest contributor.
