Bill Analysis

SB 220 requires physicians diagnosing a venereal disease to report the case to the Oklahoma and Tulsa County city-county health department, who shall in turn report the case to the State Commissioner of Health. Current law requires the physicians in these counties to report the case directly to the Commissioner. Physicians diagnosing a venereal disease outside of Oklahoma and Tulsa County will report the case directly to the Commissioner. The provisions of the measure will cease to be active after the State Department of Health establishes a disease-reporting process that provides for a direct report from a lab or physician's office to the local health department.

House Amendments

House Amendments to SB 220 add a subsection to the measure specifying the conditions under which the provisions of the measure shall terminate.
