**Bill Analysis**

SB 220 requires physicians diagnosing a venereal disease to report the case to the Oklahoma and Tulsa County city-county health department, who shall in turn report the case to the State Commissioner of Health. Current law requires the physicians in these counties to report the case directly to the Commissioner. Physicians diagnosing a venereal disease outside of Oklahoma and Tulsa County will report the case directly to the Commissioner.
