## **Bill Analysis**

SB 263 requires state agencies to publish their rules and orders on their respective websites. This applies to both exempt and nonexempt agencies with respect to the Administrative Procedures Act. The measure also authorizes small businesses requesting a review of agency rules and to receive a response within ninety days. Requests from the state Legislature and Governor must be responded to within thirty days.

Agency requests to waive the rule impact statement must be submit in writing and state the agency's findings and justification. The measure authorizes the Legislature to amend any rule submitted for its approval by a joint resolution. Additionally, the measure extends the timeframe to contest an agency rule from two years to three years.
