**Bill Analysis**

SB 271 requires all state agencies, excepting those with funds tied to maintaining any level of security clearance, to annually disclose information on their federal programs and priorities. Agencies must write a report and publish on their website a description of actions required or prohibited to obtain specific federal funding and a description of any action required or prohibited to be taken by any individual or lawfully recognized business entity or other entity tied to federal funding.
