**Bill Analysis**

SB 275 establishes procedures for a petitioner to obtain a judicial record of death. The measure applies to instances wherein a death certificate is needed settle a property or financial interest for a person who has allegedly died twenty-five or more years ago. The State Registrar of Vital Statistics must determine certain requirements are met before a person may proceed with the petition for a death certificate. After providing the information required by the measure, the petitioner may file with a court to issue a final order.
