**Bill Analysis**

SB 286 broadens provisions related to the operation of hand-held devices while driving. The measure prohibits drivers from using a handheld electronic communications device while piloting a vehicle in motion on any street or highway in the state, with the exception of when a person uses a hands free accessory. The measure also expands the definition of “electronic communication device” to include any analog or digital wireless telephone authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to operate in the frequency bandwidth reserved for cellular telephones in the definition of an electronic communication device.
