Bill Analysis

SB 288 requires individuals and entities that own or license computer data to disclose a breach of the security of the system immediately after discovery or notification of the breach of the security of the system to the Oklahoma Attorney General. The disclosure must include the scope and nature of the breach and, when practicable, the number of people affected by the breach. The Attorney General is empowered by the measure to impose a fine of up to \$50,000.00 and an additional \$1,000.00 for each day past thirty days for any failure to comply with disclosure requirements.
