**Bill Analysis**

SB 29 removes the mandated salary and qualifications of the Deputy Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigations. Current law requires the Deputy Director to possess the same qualifications as the Director and mandates that they receive 95% of the Director's salary. The measure also amends the basis of salary levels of OSBI employees. Instead of basing the salary off of the State of Oklahoma Total Remuneration Study of 2013, the salary of OSBI employees will be based solely on the recommendations of the Human Capital Management Division of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
