**Bill Analysis**

SB 315 requires the Chief Information Officer to develop a website providing public access, searchable by term, to the agendas of all open meetings held by all state agencies, boards, and commissions. The CIO must also develop a system for each state agency, board, and commission to submit their agendas to the website within twenty-four hours of the meeting.

**Fiscal Analysis**

FY'20 Impact: \$5,000.00-\$50,000.00

The provisions of SB 315 are currently already being done by the Secretary of State. If OMES's information services division were to add an entry of [openmeetings.ok.gov](https://www.sos.ok.gov/meetings/legacy/default.aspx) and point it to <https://www.sos.ok.gov/meetings/legacy/default.aspx> and then create a webform for uploads, the fiscal impact would be a minimal fiscal impact for \$5,000 or less. If OMES were to recreate what the Secretary of State is already doing, then there would be a fiscal impact of \$50,000 or less.
